PET San Antonio is an established, local 501(c)(3) nonprofit charity in San Antonio. We mobilize local volunteers and by default encourage vocational trade training, including among underserved groups such as juveniles in crisis and wounded soldiers, to make and distribute off-road wheelchairs for the 21 million people in third-world, war-ravaged and natural disaster-torn countries who have lost their lower limbs or use of them. We are 100% staffed with an all-volunteer Board and members and are 100% donor financed. Haitian relief is our first focus this red-hot minute but we serve poor countries worldwide.

Right now, we are partnering with the Haitian government and World Trade Organization through our PET International affiliation to build and ship as many PET units as we can to Haiti. Dr. June Hanks of Haiti has confirmed our PET units to be suitable to conditions in Haiti. **Ciro Rodriguez, Judge-elect Deborah Sandheinrich, the San Antonio Coalition for Veterans, Kenworth Truck Company, and Judith Markelz, Program Manager, Warrior and Family Support Center, Fort Sam Houston,** are but a few in San Antonio who believe in and support us. Volunteers are aplenty. We need funds and a larger workspace.

PET San Antonio seeks a larger workshop and capital to purchase equipment to support the Haitian campaign and to continue at a local level our global outreach to the disabled. We ask for the following types of support and enclose a Letter of Inquiry and financial and other details that validate our needs:

- ★ Donated/Leased Facility: PET has outgrown its 1,200 SF workshop and is prepared to share lease cost, if necessary, for a 4,000 SF - 4,500 SF workspace for PET production
- ★ Operating Budget/Seed Money for Operating Funds/Lease: \$60,000 cash/material donations
- ★ Capital Campaign/Production Equipment: PET owns \$20,000 in equipment; needs \$37,500 more

We appreciate your consideration. I would be happy to meet with your Trustees to discuss our PET organization and answer any questions you have, and would be very happy to offer you a personal tour of our facility and operation.
